Diana Scandridge was born in Vinton, Iowa in the 1960's during a time of revolution and change. She received her degree from the University of Northern Iowa and began teaching K-12 art in small rural Iowa towns. She has taught both young and seasoned artists how to develop their creative spirit, and helped them to express their ideas on canvas and paper. Following a desire to impact her community, she received a grant from the Calvin Institute of Worship and the Lilly Foundation to create an after-school art program for elementary children. The studio has been featured in the Hometown Press newspaper and Jasper County Living Magazine. She considers herself an accidental artist.
